The Future Of is first and foremost the opportunity to create new collaborations and partnerships around inclusive and responsible research and innovation projects.



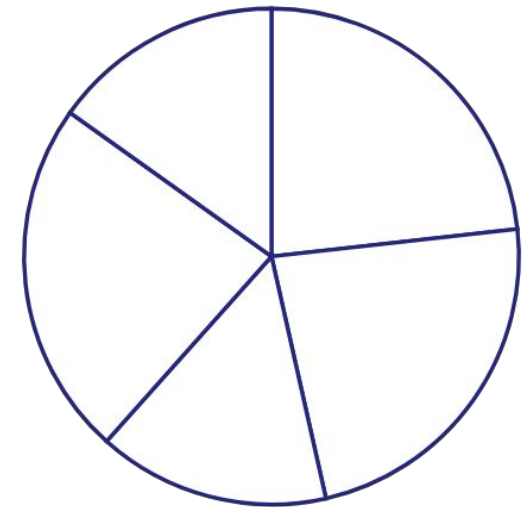

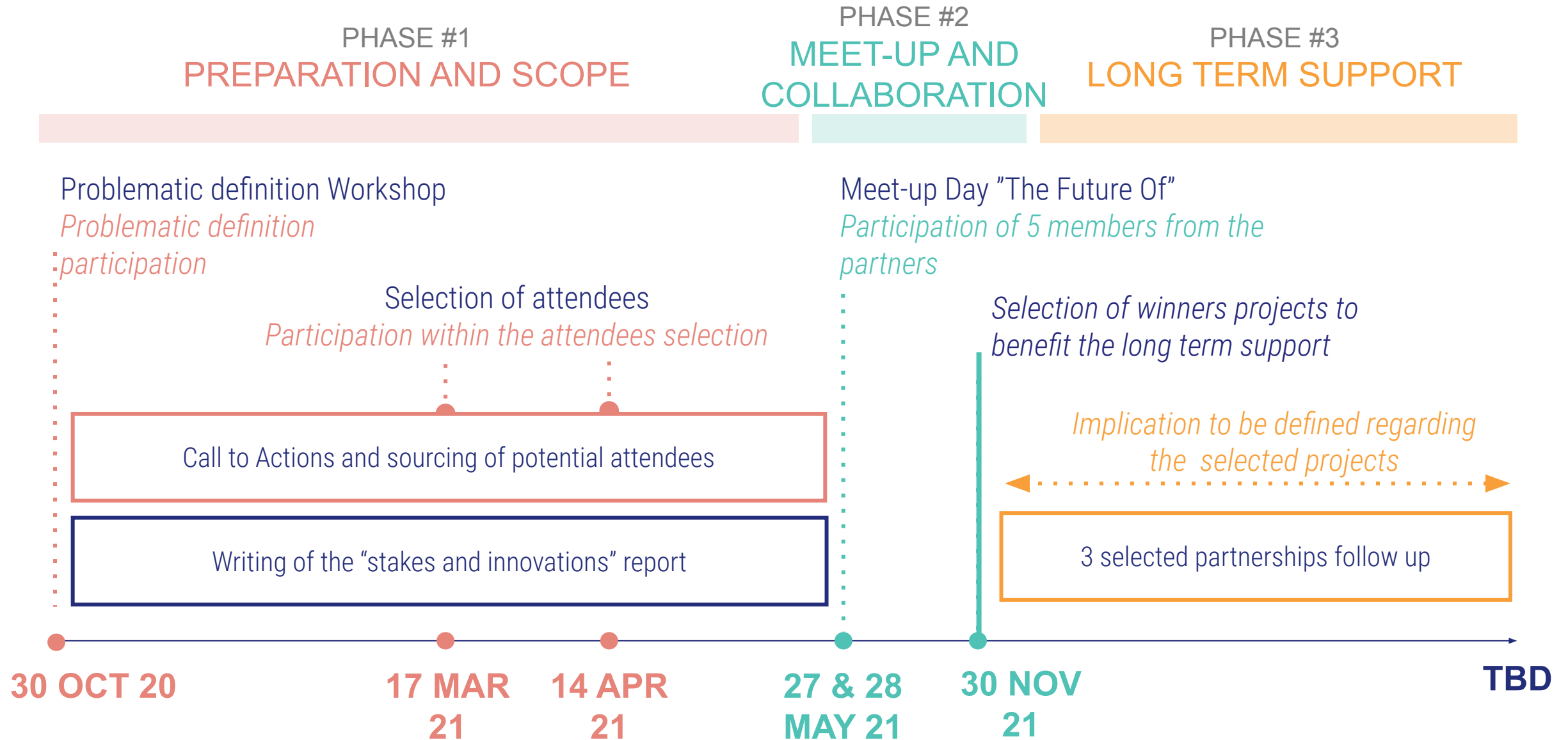

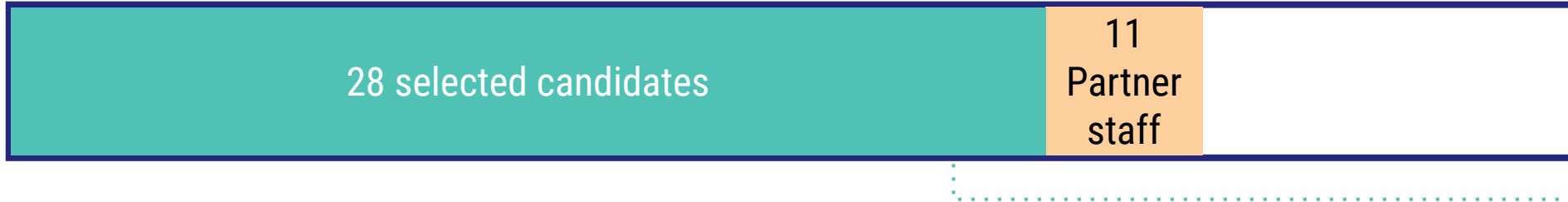

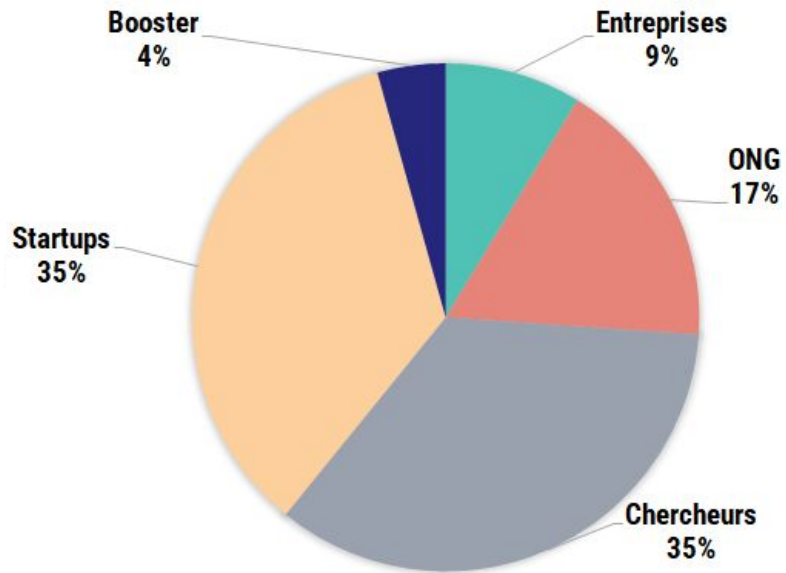

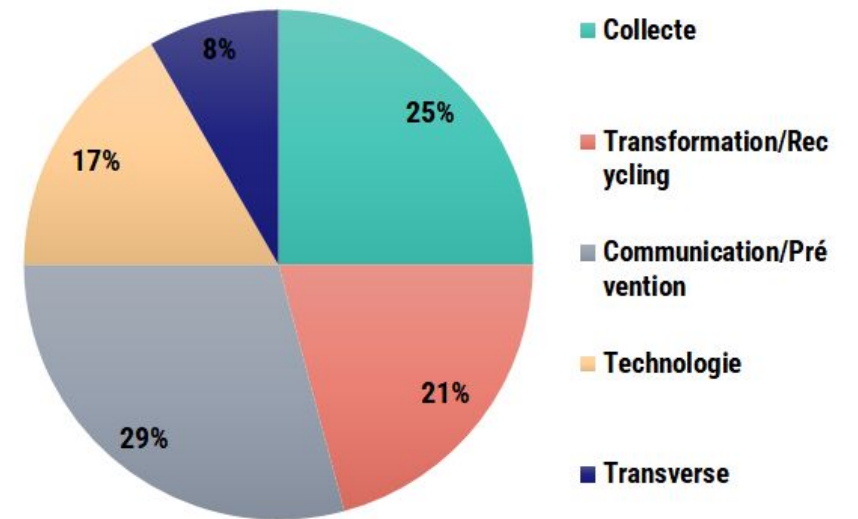


35 attendees in total

TYPE DISTRIBUTION OF THE 35 ATTENDEES

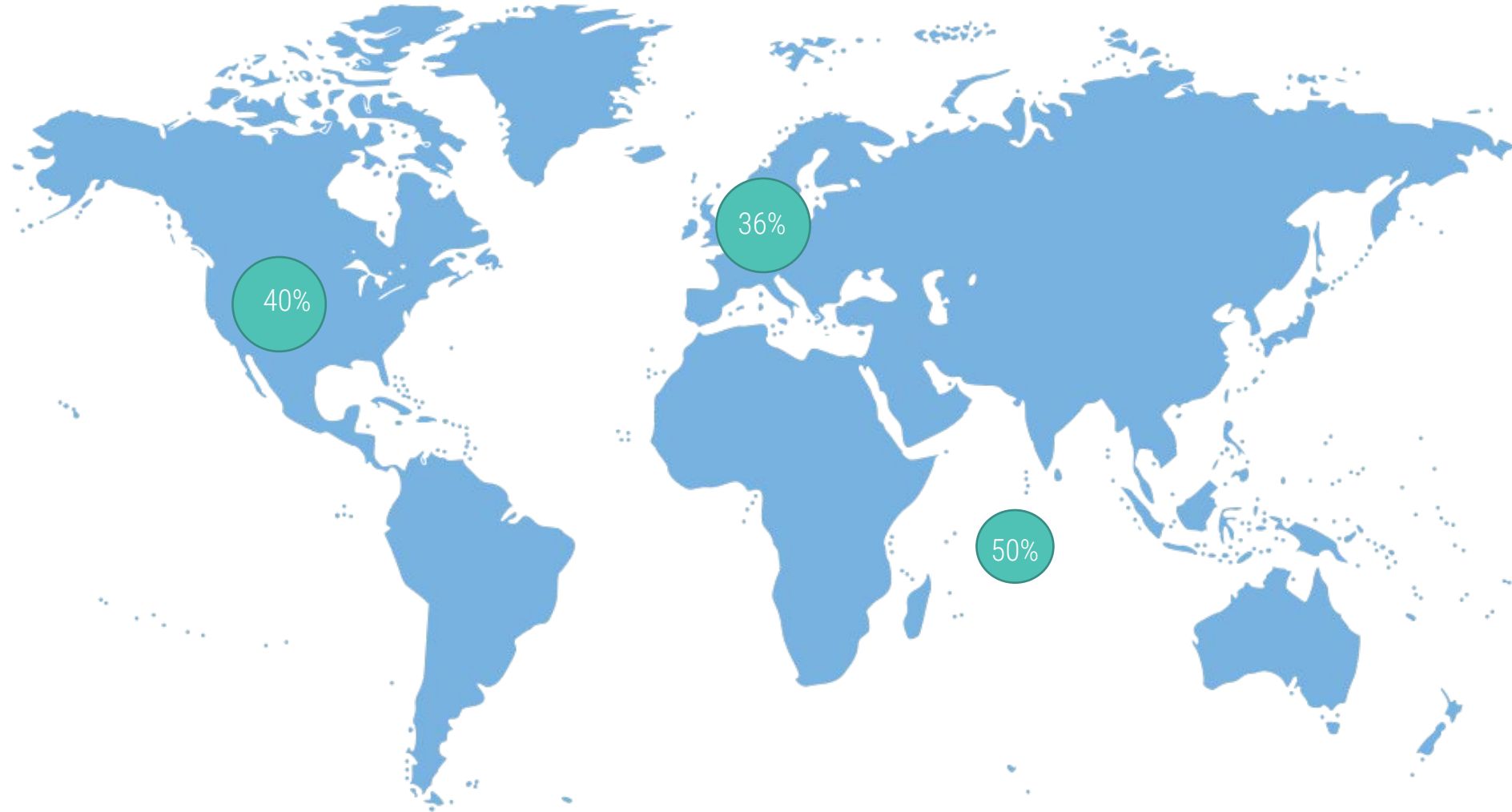


ACTIVITY DISTRIBUTION OF THE 35 ATTENDEES

6 applying projects for the follow-up program

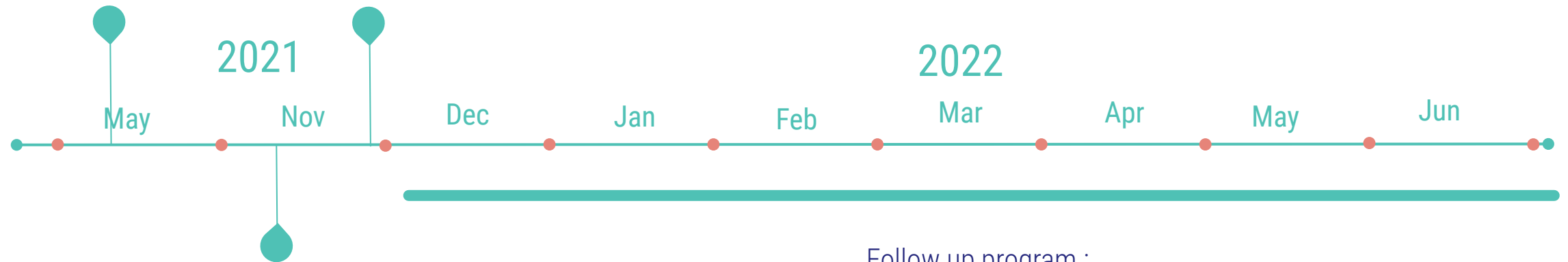
